New Academic Year 2017/18

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Welcome back to the new school year.

This year promises to be another exciting one, building on excellent GCSE and A Level results this summer. Overall results are impressive and headlines have already been published in the local media and on our website.

Exam Results 2017

Headline figures for GCSE results are as follows:

- 70% of students secured 5 or more grades at A*-C, including English and Maths.
- 44% of students secured at least one A* or A grade, with 64 students (33%) securing 3+ A*/A grades and 60 students (31%) securing 8+ grades at A*/A.
- 95 students (49%) achieved the English Baccalaureate, double the national average.
- 193 students (99%) secured 5 or more grades at A*-G.
- 192 students (99%) secured at least one grade at A*-C.
- All students (100%) secured at least one qualification.

Our Sixth Form results are as follows:

A Level:

Average Grade: B

3+ A Levels A*- E: 100%

2+ A Levels A*- E: 100%

Applied General:

Average Grade: D*

New GCSEs

We are now teaching the new GCSEs in all subjects. These syllabuses are purely exam based and have no coursework. Students will be graded from 1- 9 (9 being the highest grade).

Student Planners

Each student is given their own student planner at the start of the academic year, and this year the planner has been completely revamped from its previous design. The planner provides students a space to write homework, and also provides students with several useful reference pages. The planner is also an easy way for parents and staff to communicate with one another. For this reason, we ask that you to **check and sign your child's planner weekly**.

We have recently launched our new school website (www.sjcr.net), which has been designed to be more user-friendly, especially for those accessing the website via mobile and tablet devices. We aim to feature regular updates from the school and aim for the website to be a primary source of information for all matters relating to the school.

Free School Meals Eligibility

Children at school in Tower Hamlets whose parents / carers receive the following support payments may be entitled to free meals:

- income support
- income-based jobseeker's allowance
- the guarantee credit of pension credit
- income-related employment and support allowance
- support from NASS (National Asylum Support Service)
- an income, as assessed by the Inland Revenue, of less than £15,190 a year (*this is called the threshold amount*) and who do not get working tax credit but do get child tax credit

Please note you do not have to be claiming housing benefit or council tax benefit in order to make a claim for free school meals for your dependent children.

If you qualify under any of the above, you can claim by telephoning the benefits service on 020 7364 5001 or visiting one of the One Stop Shops:

- Bethnal Green One Stop Shop - 1 Rushmead
- Bow & North Poplar One Stop Shop - 1 Ewart Place
- South Poplar One Stop Shop - 15 Market Square
- Stepney & Wapping One Stop Shop - 260 Commercial Road

The One Stop Shops are a drop-in facility and appointments are not necessary.

Electronic Devices

We prefer students not to bring electronic devices into school, but understand that some parents feel happier knowing their child has a phone with them. Unfortunately, they can be easily damaged and, if lost, are difficult to find.

The school cannot take responsibility for electronic devices that are lost or stolen and, whilst we can assist with any investigation, we cannot promise to invest substantial amounts of staff time. I strongly advise parents to ensure that devices are covered by home insurance policies and would suggest that if it is necessary for a student to bring a device into school, they bring a cheap, basic model.

I would also like to highlight the following points:

- Mobile phones, personal hand-held devices and music players must be switched off, out of sight and not checked during the school day. If they are used, they will be confiscated.
- We trust students to use their devices appropriately. Any student who uses a device inappropriately, for example engaging in cyberbullying or any online harassment, will be banned from bringing their device into school, as well as facing further consequences.
