This letter is to inform you about arrangements for study leave. **Year 12 and 13** students will begin study leave on **Monday 18th May 2015**.

- AS/A2 Maths
- AS/A2 Media Studies

Yr 13 Vocational Subjects Study Leave Dates:

- **BTEC Business Level 3:** Friday 26th of June
- **BTEC ICT (triple award):** Monday 1st of June
- **HSC Level 3:** Friday 8th May
- **HSC PD:** Friday 8th May
- **Applied Science:** Thursday 16th July

Level 2 Study Leave Dates:

- **BTEC Business Level 2:** Friday 26th of June
- **HSC Level 2:** Friday 15th May

If any of these students are studying GCSE English and Maths then they will need to continue to attend lessons until exams are finished.

Year 12 Vocational course students for Business Studies, Personal Finance, Health and Social Care, ICT and Applied Science will carry on with normal lessons throughout the study leave period and must attend all lessons as normal.

It is compulsory for students to attend the designated lessons otherwise teachers will withdraw them from examinations and courses. Students need to use the study leave period to prepare for examinations; a minimum of 6 hours should be spent on revision each day. They can use the library, VLE and ILC for independent study; if this is not the case, students will be sent home.

Year 12 Return from Study Leave

Year 12 advanced level students will return from study leave and resume normal lessons from Monday 29th June 2015. Any student failing to attend will not be able to continue to year 13 in September. Students will continue with their current subjects in preparation for A2. Any subject changes will be discussed after results day on Thursday 13th August 2015.
