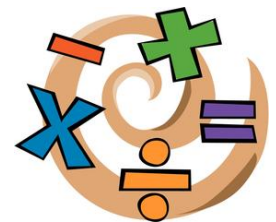
Post-16: impending - an event or situation, especially an unpleasant
