<p>Assessment</p> <p>Each unit of work is marked to National Curriculum levels. Pupils also evaluate their work and progress and respond to feedback. Individual pieces of work are formatively marked following the school’s assessment policy to provide constant feedback and progression. Students are expected to correct their own work and respond to teacher comments using the school assessment proforma.</p> <p>Literacy</p> <p>Pupils develop speaking and listening skills. Pupils provide oral and written evaluation of their work. Year 8 pupils develop a manga story board. The promotion of independent research allows pupils to develop ideas in depth. Reading enriches their subject knowledge and technical vocabulary. Pupils use the correct technical language.
