

Background

The Pupil Premium Funding is based on Free School Meals (FSM) eligibility but it includes both current Free School Meal pupils and those who have been on Free School Meals at any point in the last 6 years. As has been reported previously, there are also pupils who need additional support to raise their standards of achievement so the School wants to support all students whether they are entitled to FSM or not. The School is using the Pupil Premium Funding to fund 1-to-1 tuition for the students through Academic Tutoring, Learning Support Assistants and various Service Level Agreements with the Local Authority.

Pupil Premium Eligibility

- Pupils in year groups 7-11, known to have been eligible for free school meals at any point in the last 6 years.
- Looked After Children

Pupil Premium is not ring-fenced and schools are free to use it in ways which they know to be best for their cohort. But schools are to be held to account for impact of expenditure, reporting to Governors/ Parents and monitored via performance tables and Ofsted.

Ofsted inspectors will want to see that school's use of the Pupil Premium in order to narrow/ close the gap between FSM and non-FSM pupils in English and Maths.

There is a greater focus on:

- Narrowing gaps in performance for groups of pupils, particularly for pupils known to be eligible for free school meals and for disabled pupils and those with special needs.
- Quality of teaching and its impact on learning and progress
- Reading and literacy
- Behaviour and safety
- How well governors, leaders and managers drive school improvement and use resources effectively, particularly the pupil premium

Commentary/ Explanation

In the summaries that follow, there are two tables for each year group. The first table looks at the comparison of the end of year grade to Value Added (VA) target for each subject to give us a residual. Residuals have been given for the whole cohort, for Pupil Premium (PP) students only and for non PP students so that comparisons can be made. A positive figure indicates that students in that particular cohort have on average exceeded their VA target.

The second table looks at attainment and simply calculates the number of students that have achieved certain grades in terms of a percentage. Again percentages have been given for the whole cohort, for PP students only and for non PP students so that comparisons can be made.

For the Governors' information, there are 6 points in a GCSE grade, so 1 point is 1/6 of the GCSE grade.

For year 7, both PP and non PP students on average achieved positive residual scores in all Ebacc subjects apart from Bengali and Spanish. In Bengali this was half a GCSE grade below target whilst for both cohorts whilst for Spanish this was no more than 0.75 points (1/8 of a GCSE grade) for both groups. On average PP students performed better than Non-PP students in Maths, Science, History, French and Spanish. Non PP students on average performed better in English and Geography. Across all subjects the residual difference between PP and non PP students was no more than 0.5 points (1/12 of a GCSE grade).

For year 8, both PP and non PP students on average achieved positive residual scores in all Ebacc subjects apart from French and Spanish. On average PP students performed better than Non-PP students in Bengali and Spanish. Non PP students on average performed better in all other Ebacc subjects with the greatest residual difference being just over 0.6 points (1/10 of a GCSE grade) in Geography.

For year 9, both PP and non PP students achieved on average positive residual scores in all Ebacc subjects apart from Spanish. On average PP students performed better than Non-PP students in Geography, History and Science. In Geography PP students performed better by 1.2 points (1/5 of a GCSE grade) on average. Non PP students on average performed better in all other Ebacc subjects with the greatest residual differences being just over 1 point (1/6 of a GCSE grade) in English and Maths.

For Year 10, PP students on average achieved positive residual scores in all Ebacc subjects apart from Maths. Non PP students on average performed better in all other Ebacc subjects with the greatest residual differences being almost 3 points (1/2 a GCSE grade) in Maths. On average PP students performed better than Non-PP students in Bengali, Geography and Spanish. In Bengali and Geography PP students performed better than Non PP students by almost 2 points (1/3 of a GCSE grade) on average.

For Year 11, both PP and non PP students on average achieved positive residual scores in all Ebacc subjects. On average PP students performed better than Non-PP students in English, French Geography and History. In History and Geography PP students performed better than Non PP students by approximately 1 point (1/6 of a GCSE grade) on average. 80% of students that were entered for triple Science GCSE exams were PP students who on average exceeded their value added target by over a GCSE grade.
