What is Enrichment?

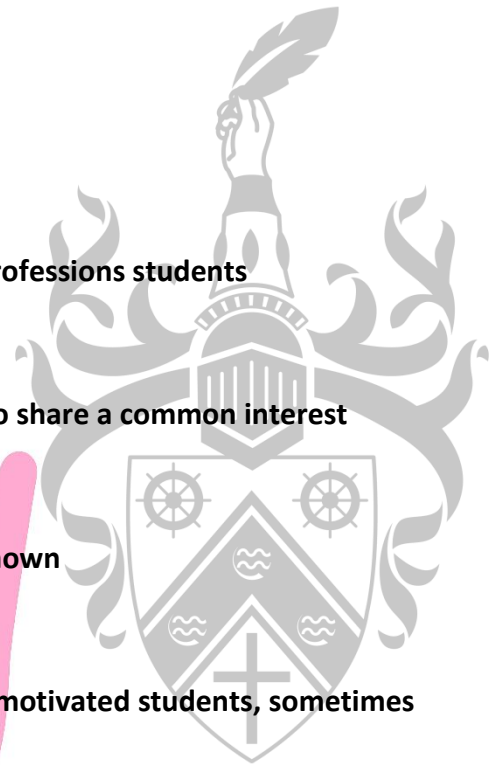
