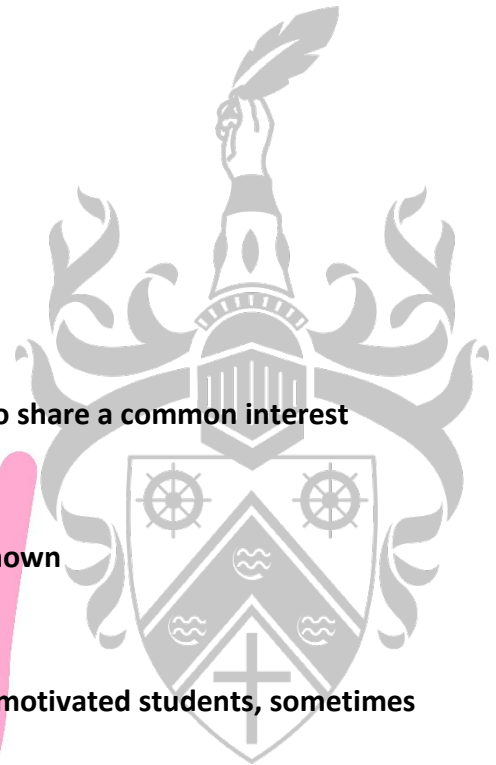
What is Enrichment?
