

GCSE Results

- The school has a Progress 8 score of +0.6. This means that on average students get +0.6 of a grade better at Sir John Cass & Red Coat School compared to other schools nationally.
- Girls achieved +0.76 of a grade better compared to other students nationally.
- Boys achieved +0.47 of a grade better compared to other students nationally.
- 73% of students achieved a 4+ in English and Maths.
- 57% of students achieved a 5+ in English and Maths.
- 70% of students achieved 5 GCSEs 9-4 including English and Maths.
