The amount of Pupil Premium allocation that the school received for the previous Academic Year (September 2015- August 2016)

The school received £653,880 for the academic year 2015/16 (September 2015 – August 2016).

How the school spent the 2015/16 Pupil Premium allocation

The school used this money to support systems and processes which ensured continued progress and academic achievement for those in vulnerable groups (Looked After Children and pupils entitled to Free School Meals). The school continued with programmes, projects and initiatives which supported the engagement and involvement of disadvantaged students. These included the following: 1-to-1 Tuition through Academic Tutoring, projects relating to behaviour, pastoral support, various Service Level Agreements with the Local Authority in order to support the disadvantaged students, extra curriculum activities and afternoon clubs, revision programmes, trips subsidies.

The impact of the expenditure on eligible and other students

The school has in place rigorous monitoring and support systems. The outcomes for these students, as demonstrated in attainment data, compares favourably with national benchmarking.
