

## **Pupil Premium Achievement Update – July 2017**

- For students who qualify for pupil premium funding, their performance is compared to non-pupil premium students nationally so as to ensure the highest expectations of progress and attainment for our most disadvantaged pupils. The comparator for attainment is the “national other” figure achieving the old A\*-C (shown in the final column of the PP Achievement Appendix), which is the percent of non-disadvantaged pupils nationally achieving A\*-C in each subject in 2016. This number is higher than the national average for all pupils because it excludes those students who are most disadvantaged.

### **Updates to Pupil Premium Achievement from tracking period C**

- Year 10 and year 11 have each had an additional tracking period since the last pupil premium report was produced, and the updates for these are in the pupil premium appendix.
- The data shows that the percentage of disadvantaged pupils making good progress in year 10 and 11 continues to increase across Ebacc subjects.
- Attainment data shows that our most disadvantaged pupils in year 10 and 11 are outperforming their non-disadvantaged counterparts nationally across Ebacc subjects.

### **Progress summary for the year**

- Across years 7-11 in the core subjects, student progress towards target grades is good and in line with national expectations and when compared to their non-disadvantaged counterparts nationally.
- Progress in other Ebacc subjects (languages and humanities) is slightly depressed in year 7 and 8, where students did not study the subjects prior to entering secondary school in year 11. This is because their target grades are set with the same rigour as English, maths and Science targets, despite students being new to these subjects in year 7.
- Progress in other Ebacc subjects comes back in line with the core in year 10 and 11, where progress is good across all Ebacc subjects except year 11 Geography. This is being addressed.

### **Attainment summary for the year**

- Year 11 pupil premium student attainment, compared to national “other” data from 2016 is good across all Ebacc subjects. The gap has closed for all subjects and in many cases our disadvantaged pupils are currently outperforming their non-disadvantaged counterparts nationally at grades 9-4 (A\*-C4).
- Year 10 pupil premium student attainment is lower, generally than year 11 attainment, and lower than 2016 national “other” data, but they are only one third of the way through their courses. Progress indicators for Ebacc subjects are positive showing good progress towards target grades for this stage in their studies.
- Year 9 pupil premium student attainment, compared to national “other” data from 2016 is good across all Ebacc subjects. The gap has closed for all subjects and in many cases our disadvantaged pupils are on track to outperform their non-disadvantaged counterparts nationally at grades 9-4 (A\*-C4) when they sit their GCSE exams in 2019.
- Year 7-8 pupil premium student attainment is good across the core when compared with national “other” students. It varies in other Ebacc subjects where students have not studied these prior to year 7.
