Dear Parents,

As we progress through the Autumn term, I wanted to take this opportunity to write to you with some key information and reminders for students in year 11. It was great to see so many of you at the Parent's Information Evening on 18th September and I hope that the advice given with regards to GCSE examinations, revision and preparation is proving to be useful.

Attendance and punctuality

Good attendance is firmly linked with academic success and as such it is expected that pupils maintain a high level of attendance. This is particularly important for year 11 students as we approach key examination periods. A reminder that in the first instance, if your child presents themselves to you as 'unwell' then please send them to school regardless. At school we have a full-time medical needs coordinator, Ms Anderson. If they continue to feel unwell Ms Anderson can assess them and we will call you should there be a need for them to go home. We strongly encourage students to take any medical and dental appointments outside of school hours so that vital learning opportunities are not missed.

The school day starts at 8.40am and as such students are expected to be in their form rooms for registration at this time. Students arriving after 8.40am are issued with a late detention the same day; this may lead to them missing crucial After School Tuition opportunities.

Year 11 November mock examinations

Mock exams will start on Monday 18th November and will cover all subjects. A timetable for the exams will be issued in due course.

Revision

All students have created a revision timetable and should now be following this programme at home on evenings and weekends. Your support in monitoring this crucial study is very much appreciated. Students have been provided with a GCP revision guide and a topic lists booklet to help them cover all content. We would like to reinforce the weekly parent signature in the student planner requirement as a confirmation that revision is taking place.

A revision 'Night Club' will soon operate between 4-5pm for students who show signs of not making required progress towards examinations and also those who would welcome a quiet and dedicated space to study in school at that time.

If you have concerns that your child is not completing at home revision or homework, we encourage you to get in touch with their form tutor or head of year so that we can offer support and address this issue.

Homework

Homework remains a key part of GCSE preparation and the expectation remains that students complete every piece to the best of their ability. Overleaf you can see the October Half Term homework set in all subjects. Sanctions will be given to those who do not complete it, we are grateful for your support in monitoring its completion.
