YEAR 11 PASSPORT TO THE PROM PROGRAMME





In order to give Year 11 a final push in the build up to the GCSE exams we are launching the Year 11 Passport to the Prom Programme.

Students are required to achieve **100 Passport To The Prom points** in order to attend prom. All students start from zero.

This programme will run for 4 teaching weeks between Monday 1st April – Friday 10th May 2019.

Students can achieve these points as follows:

Retrospective Awards for Mock Exam performance:

Commendation	5 points	near to their target grade
Cass Star	10 points	hitting their target grade
Cass Diamond	20 points	exceeding their target grade
Head Teacher's Award	50 points	hitting/exceeding target grades in 6 or more subjects

Awards:

Commendation	5 points	 attending and performing diligently in extension clubs/revision clubs/mentoring/Night club perfect attendance and punctuality (weekly) excellent performance in a lesson excellent piece of homework
Cass Star	10 points	 attending Saturday Sessions/Easter revision sessions attending an enrichment activity devising a rigorous revision timetable producing a set of revision notes/folder per subject excellent performance in an exam based assessment
Cass Diamond	20 points	exceeding their target grade
Head Teacher's Award	50 points	hitting/exceeding target grades in 6 or more subjects

Teachers/Tutors can also award Merits (2 points), Commendations and Cass Stars at their own discretion whilst HoY/SLT can also award Cass Diamonds and Head Teacher's Award.

Other rewards/prizes will be on offer for students who surpass this target score.
